#### **TEAM 2013**

The volunteer team had a great trip in October. 8 of us went to build partnership. We joined in the 20 year celebration since the start of the church in 2003. As well as making deep friendships, we helped with Nursery School training, computer training, sewing, helping finish the church and community office (that we started in 2011), youth services and health work.

# LOOKING AHEAD

The church in Tanzania continues to grow in Revival, in love and in prayer. They also reach out to 330 Compassion children. Health remains the biggest issue. In a WHO report, Tanzania was 93rd out of 94 countries, as being the worst place to live for your health in old age.

As a Trust, we have a vision to address chronic health conditions in the local church and community. On the Team 2013 trip, we met with a local Doctor who runs a dispensary in Dodoma and the Archbishop (yes: I met with an Archbishop for a whole hour!). Our vision for church and community health, outreach and water supply from wells are the same as the Archbishop's for the nation! How good is that! He advised us to "leap out of our comfort zone"!

# WATER NEWS

The Tanzanian Government is helping the church and community in Mpwayungu to replace their broken pump, praise God. We helped the church community in drilling the well some years ago, but they have had on-going problems with the pump. The church well in Dodoma continues to pump up plentiful water to supply water for the church (1,000 strong now) and neighbours and for their church fields. The church fields produce great vegetables which helps finance church work, as well as support the workers (vegetables in place of some wages).
