Dodoma, Tanzania. Nov 2019

*The Health Centre Tazama na Tunza Dispensary is steadily growing in experience and reputation. More than 30 patients a day are seen by the Dr, have their lab tests & results, see Dr again and then receive their advice, treatment & medication. Thank you for all your prayers, support & encouragement. We continue to support TTD £500 a month and will do until they are self sufficient. We have a new nurse called Bertha. We also have paid for air conditioning for the laboratory, which the Government Inspector requested.*

*We are still waiting for the allocated Government fridge before the Mamas Unit can open! Hopefully January...*

*Zeph shared this story: A young man Alex was in a serious motor-bike accident in his village where his ankle's flesh was ripped away. He went to hospital but then could not pay for the continued treatment. His ankle deteriorated until he came to TTD where we could dress his ankle daily and he could pay the small fees we charge. He is now walking again & even riding a bike.*



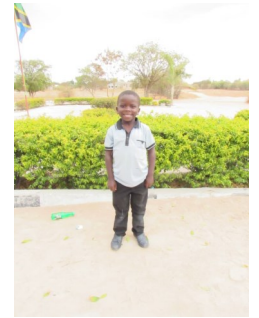

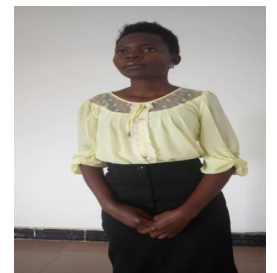
***Zeph & Wema came for a sabbatical rest for the month of November at the request of their Church in Dodoma. This news-sheet outlines some of the stories that they shared about mission, Revival, and outreach through our Health Centre (TTD) and the church nursery school.***

Elisha was attending the Church nurse school when his mother died. His father was a drunk & at 7 years old no one cared for or fed him. The Church visited his home & a Church family fostered him. He had tests at TTD & he is HIV positive. He is now on medication, is in better health, eating well, is loved & cared for & happily attending nursery school



The Nursery School has 16 children in similar situations & are looking for 50 people to give £5 a month to support them.

Elizabethi is 23. She was a lapsed Christian who had fallen into very bad habits with men. Zeph, Wema & Margaret are in the habit of visiting the Church members weekly, especially the new converts. They visited Elizabethi & she turned again to Jesus. She has now committed herself to a year of prayer: she stays 6 days a week at the House of Prayer & returns home to her parents 1 night a week to bath and wash her clothes. She has started serving at the Church and often can be heard praying most of the night.
