Some of the team with Zeph, outside the Health Centre, now 2 years old, pre-COVID. The government has asked that Health Centres place people in isolation rooms if they have C19 symptoms, so we have prepared 2 classrooms with mattresses and 1 room for changing clothes, in the closed Church School opposite the Health Centre. There is hand-washing outside the centre and the Government has supplied masks so that everyone entering has to wear a mask to protect the staff and other patients. There is no specialist care for C19.



In the middle of COVID, after waiting nearly 2 years (!) we had a phone call saying that they will inspect our MAMAS UNIT prior to opening. The team prayed so they could furnish it, they did and then the inspectors have not come—yet! Pray they come! And with the promised Government fridge!
