One mama 's story

"Last October, when we visited Tanzania Zeph asked me to visit Mama X. As I listened to her story, I became convinced that her main problem was simple women's thrush. However it had reached such a degree of chronic inflammation and pain that she could hardly walk for over 2 years.

For this condition in UK, you just go to a chemist and buy treatment over the counter as a cream, pessary or 1 tablet. I explained to her what thrush is, how to wash herself and prevent thrush re-occurring. I said that I happened to have the medication in the medicines I had brought and that she could take it and be better in 2 days. She started crying. She told me that if we hadn't called that day, she was going to go her village tomorrow to die, as she was no good as a wife or a person. We prayed together and we could see hope rising. Two days later she was walking pain-free, the thrush had cleared and she was happy and full of hope for her marriage and her life.

When I returned this year in April, she had changed so much: she had gained weight and she and her husband had been chosen as church plant leaders. They are being trained for this now. She was glowing with happiness. She also came on our health training course." *Ruth*

As well as having started the "Tazama na Tunza" voluntary health team, we are now planning to build a **Health Centre** to provide good care and medicines for the community. The plot of land has been given and the drawings have been done. The chronic health situation in Tanzania is dire: they have some of the worst statistics in the world for health.
