TAZAMA NA TUNZA HEALTH CENTRE NEWS

Peace was abandoned by her father as a child, then her mother, and then the father of her expected baby - as she would not have an abortion. She turned up at our Health Centre, having travelled to Dodoma without support and without any antenatal care for her pregnancy—about 8 months on. She was going to ask her friend to support her, as she had no family, and there are no government benefits or support (as in the UK). However, when she arrived in Dodoma at her friend's, she started with stomach pains, and delivered her baby at the Health Centre over a month early. The Health Centre saved her life, but sadly the baby died as his lungs were immature, and there are no special care baby units as we know them in Dodoma. This photo is of our Pharmacist Chip and Peace's friend, outside the Hospital that they drove Peace to, to try and save the baby's life.
